SALIENT FEATURES OF NEW NOTES ISSUES

We give below salient features of New Bank Notes issued by the RBI of denomination 2000,500,200 & 50

(1) Rs.2000 Note

Obverse (Front)

1. See through register with denominational numeral 2000
2. Latent image with denominational numeral 2000
3. Denominational numeral २००० in Devnagari
4. Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre
5. Micro letters 'RBI' and '2000' on the left side of the banknote
6. Windowed security thread with inscriptions 'भारत', RBI and 2000 on banknotes with color Shift. Colour of the thread changes from green to blue when the note is tilted.
7. Guarantee Clause, Governor's signature with Promise Clause and RBI emblem towards right.
8. Denominational numeral with Rupee Symbol, Rs.2000 in colour changing ink (green to blue) on bottom right.
9. Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right Mahatma Gandhi portrait and electrotype (2000) watermarks
10. Number panel with numerals growing from small to big on the top left side and bottom right side

For visually impaired

Intaglio or raised printing of Mahatma Gandhi portrait, Ashoka Pillar emblem, bleed lines and identity mark

11. Horizontal rectangle with Rs.2000 in raised print on the right
12. Seven angular bleed lines on left and right side in raised print

Reverse (Back)

13. Year of printing of the note on the left
14. Swachh Bharat logo with slogan
15. Language panel towards the centre
16. Motif of Mangalayan
17. Denominational numeral २००० in Devnagari

Dimension

18. 66 mm*166 mm

(2) Rs.500 Note

The new Rs. 500 banknotes are different from the earlier specified bank note (SBN) series in colour, size, theme, location of security features and design elements; the principal features are

- The size is 66mm x150mm
- The colour is stone grey
- Red Fort-an image of Indian heritage site with Indian flag on the reverse

The banknote also has features (intaglio printing of Mahatma Gandhi portrait, Ashoka Pillar emblem, bleed lines, circle with ₹ 500 in the right, and the identification mark) which enable the visually impaired person to identify the denomination.

(3) Rs.200 Note

Obverse (Front)

1. See through register with denominational numeral 200
2. Latent image with denominational numeral 200
3. Denominational numeral ₹०० in Devnagari
4. Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre
5. Micro letters 'RBI', 'भारत', 'India' and '200'
6. Windowed security thread with inscriptions 'भारत' and RBI with colour shift. Colour of the thread changes from green to blue when the note is tilted .
7. Guarantee Clause, Governor's signature with Promise Clause and RBI emblem towards right of Mahatma Gandhi portrait
8. Denominational numeral with Rupee Symbol, ₹ 200 in colour changing ink (green to blue) on bottom right
9. Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right
10. Mahatma Gandhi portrait and electrotype (200) watermarks
11. Number panel with numerals growing from small to big on the top left side and bottom right side.

For visually impaired

12. Intaglio or raised printing of Mahatma Gandhi portrait, Ashoka Pillar emblem, raised Identification mark **H** with micro-text ₹200, four angular bleed lines with two circles in between the lines both on the right and left sides

Reverse (Back)

13. Year of printing of the note on the left
14. Swachh Bharat logo with slogan
15. Language panel
16. Motif of Sanchi Stupa

17. Denominational numeral २०० in Devnagari

Dimension

18. 66 mm*146 mm

(4) Rs.50 Note

The base colour of the new Rs.50 note is Fluorescent Blue. All the Banknotes in the denomination of Rs.50. issued by the RBI in the earlier series will continue to be legal tender.

Obverse (Front)

1. See through register with denominational numeral 50,
2. Denominational numeral ५० in Devnagari
3. Portrait of Mahatma Gandhi at the centre
4. Micro letters 'RBI', 'भारत', 'INDIA' and '50
5. Windowed demetalised security thread with inscriptions 'भारत' and RBI
6. Guarantee Clause, Governor's signature with Promise Clause and RBI emblem towards right of Mahatma Gandhi portrait
7. Ashoka Pillar emblem on the right
8. Mahatma Gandhi portrait and electrotype (50) watermarks
9. Number panel with numerals growing from small to big on the top left side and bottom right side.

Reverse (Back)

10. Year of printing of the note on the left,
11. Swachh Bharat logo with slogan,
12. Language panel,
13. Motif of **Hampi with Chariot**,
14. Denominational numeral ५० in Devnagari

Dimension
